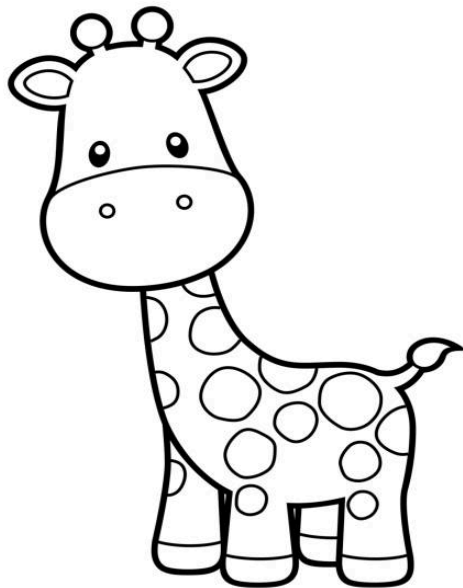


Welcome to the Giraffe Room!

Each day includes experiences that foster creative expression, cognitive development, social and emotional growth, motor skills, and problem-solving skills, while providing nurturing and loving care.

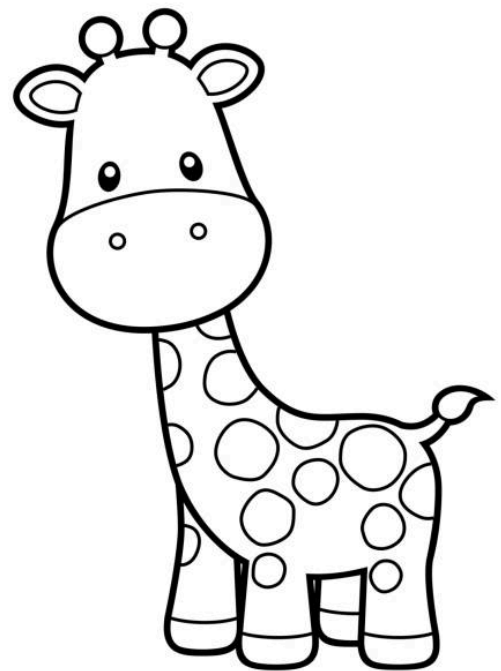


Giraffe Room

Sample Schedule

Parents must provide a schedule for their child's day when they are in the Giraffe Room. A **sample** daily schedule is below:

7:30-9:00	Welcome
9:00	Diapers
9:15	Bottles & Breakfast
9:30	Circlertime & Play (tummy time, sensory exploration, etc.)
10:15	Nap
11:00	Diapers
11:15	Learning & Play Activities (tummy time, sensory exploration, crafts etc.)
12:15	Bottles & Lunch
1:00	Diapers
1:15	Nap
2:30	Learning & Play Activities
3:00	Diapers
3:15	Bottles & Snack
3:30-6:00	Activity & Exploration Time



What Does My Child Need For The Giraffe Room?

- Written or typed schedule of your child's day. Please include things such as feedings, naps, play times/tummy time, etc. Include any other notes our teachers should know about your child's routine.
- Diapers, wipes, and diaper cream.
- Crib sheet and sleep sack/wearable blanket. No blankets, swaddles, or stuffed animals are allowed as per state licensing regulations. These items are to be sent into school on Mondays to be used for the week and sent home on Fridays to be washed.
- Bottles—must be pre-made and will be kept in the fridge until they need to be warmed up. Be sure to send enough bottles for the entire day. You may choose to send in an extra bottle and extra formula to be kept with your child's belongings and/or breast milk to be kept in the freezer in the event that we need extra at any given time. All glass bottles must have silicone sleeves.
- Food, utensils, and bibs (if needed).
- Seasonally appropriate extra clothes to keep in cubby.
- Sunscreen (pump or stick only—no aerosol or continuous sprays are allowed) and a hat for outside time, if desired.
- Backpack/diaper bag that fits all belongings inside.

Please remember to label all belongings are labeled with your child's name to avoid any confusion
