

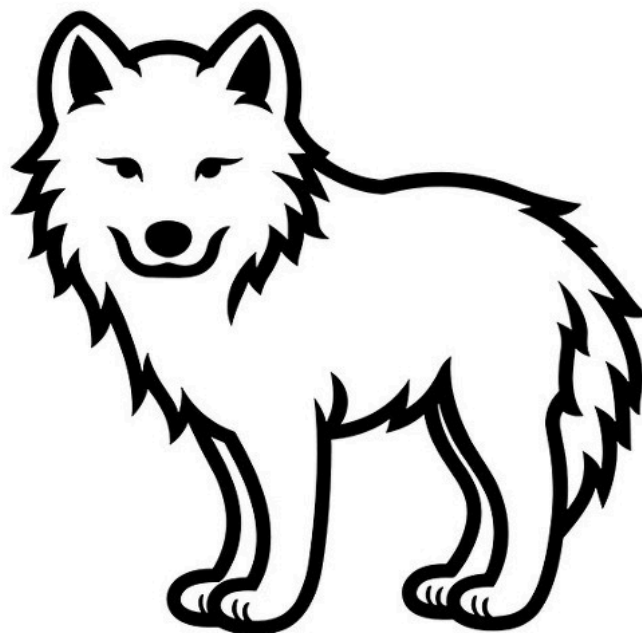
Welcome to the Wolf Room!

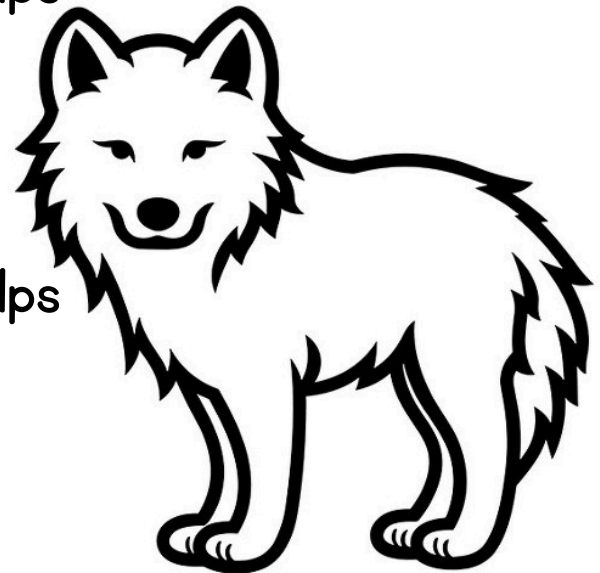
The Wolf Room also begins working on potty training with the children, in conjunction with families working on it at home when their child is ready.

What Does My Child Need For The Wolf Room?

- Pull ups (must have the velcro sides) or diapers, wipes, and diaper cream.
- Crib sheet and blanket for nap time. These items are to be sent into school on Mondays to be used for the week and sent home on Fridays to be washed.
- Lunch packed inside a lunchbox with any necessary utensils. Teachers are able to microwave food if needed for lunchtime.
- Cups-leak-proof sippy cups filled with water and/or milk. Teachers will refill water cups throughout the day as needed.
- Seasonally appropriate full set of extra clothes and shoes to keep in cubby.
- Sunscreen (pump or stick only-no aerosol or continuous sprays are allowed) and a hat for outside time, if desired. Mittens can be sent in the winter-gloves may only be sent if the child can put them on without assistance.
- Backpack that fits lunchbox, papers, projects, and all belongings inside.

Please remember to label all belongings are labeled with your child's name to avoid any confusion
